As a member of the band you are expected to follow all the Don Lugo High School student rules as well as all of the following guidelines. As a member of the Don Lugo High School Band you represent the band as well as the entire school. Keep all of this in mind as we strive for new goals in 2009-2010

Mission Statement

The everyday mission of the Don Lugo band and color guard is to perform to its full musical and marching capacity, to learn independently and collectively as to contribute to the success of the team. Our commitment to band and others will create a positive environment where followers become leaders and leaders rise to new levels as we strive for excellence in all that we do.





Band Guidelines

Musicians and color guard will be referred to as students.

- ♪ Follow all school rules as outlined in the district guidelines.
- ♪ Respect everyone. This includes all staff, student leaders and classmates.
- ♪ No talking while the director/leader is on the podium.
- ♪ Be prepared to rehearse or perform at the announced time.
- ♪ No food (including candy), beverage (water OK), or gum chewing.
- ♪ Strive to improve your musicianship and performing skills.
- ♪ Use your instrument or equipment only.
- ♪ Be responsible for the care of your instrument, equipment and all music assigned to you.
- ♪ After class, put everything properly away (this includes all personal belongings).
- ♪ Read the information sent home and share the information with your parents or guardians. This includes newsletters, calendars, information about fundraisers and field trips.
- ♪ Check the website: donlugobandboosters.com for updated information.
- ♪ No Public Display of Affection. Keep your hands and other body parts to yourself.

Students are expected to follow all school rules and band guidelines. Failure to do so may result in one or more of the following actions:

- ✓ Detention
- ✓ Teacher contact of parent or guardian
- ✓ Parent-student-teacher-administrator conference
- ✓ Saturday school
- ✓ Suspension from class and/or performance(s)
- ✓ Removal from the band program



Dress Code

School dress code will be strictly enforced at school and at school activities.

Extracurricular/Co-curricular Activities:

The principal, staff, students, and parents/guardians at each school may establish reasonable dress and grooming regulations for times when students are engaged in

extracurricular or other special school activities.

In addition to complying with the district dress code, below are additional requirements for the band program:

1. Band "Pride" shirts must be worn all day on spirit days.
2. For Wednesday night practices, the Wednesday night practice shirt and practice shoes must be worn.
3. For all marching band practices, a pair of marching band practice shoes must be worn. If proper shoes are not worn, you will receive no participation credit for the day.
4. For rehearsals shirts must be full length and have sleeves (this applies to all band members).
5. No jewelry may be worn for performances.
6. Be ready with all clothing required for performance and afterwards (this includes travel clothes and shoes) before departing on the bus. Failure to do so will result in not being able to perform at the event.
7. When wearing your uniform you must wear the following undergarments.
Marching Students:
 - A plain white t-shirt with no design
 - White shorts with no design
 - Full length all white socks with no designsColor Guard Students:
 - Body suit
8. Band "travel" T-shirts must be worn on marching band competition days.

Eligibility

A 2.0 grade point average must be maintained every grading period to be eligible for extra curricular activities. Marching band and Winterguard competitions, football games, and trips are extra curricular activities.

- ♪ Students will be on "probation" if their grade point average falls below 2.0 and will lose their position in marching band for the year if it happens twice. ***This includes being dropped from zero periods.***
- ♪ All student leaders must maintain a 2.5 grade point average.
- ♪ Student leaders will be on "probation" if their grade point average falls below 2.5 and lose their position if it happens twice during the year.

Attendance

Participation in all scheduled practices, rehearsals and performances is vital for the success

of the band. Practices will be posted every Monday on the class room bulletin board and on the website under the chalk board link. Students are also given a calendar of all key dates which is also posted on the www.donlugobandboosters.com website.

- ♪ Zero Period: during first semester, all marching band students are enrolled in PE/Marching Band. This graded class is held every Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday at 6:30 a.m.
- ♪ Practices: Practices are held every Monday after school and Wednesday evenings and are part of the band PE class. There will also be a few practices held on Saturday, refer to the calendar for dates.

Failure to attend a practice or performance will result in the following consequences:

One unexcused absence will forfeit your privilege of performing at the next function.

Two unexcused tardies equal one unexcused absence.

Three unexcused absences will forfeit your privilege of being a member of the current marching season.

- A student is considered tardy when they are not ready to participate in the rehearsal at the announced time.
- When a student plans on being late to a practice or performance, the director must excuse the lateness before the event.
- If a student cannot attend a practice or performance for any reason other than illness, the director must excuse the absence before the event.
- An unexcused missed performance will result in the lowering of the student's participation grade by a **FULL GRADE**.

Excuses are the same as for school, a note from a parent/guardian is required to excuse any tardy or absence. The note must be turned in three days before the absence or tardy or within three days after. In the case of illness, the note must be turned in on the day the student returns.

***Attendance for all activities does have an affect on YOUR grade. ***

Grading

Students are graded on the following criteria per each 6-week grading period:

- ♪ Musical and / or skill improvement-25%
- ♪ Day to day monitoring of the students contribution – 25%
- ♪ Points earned during rehearsals -25%

- ♪ Practice records (home practice)-25%
- ♪ Written work / tests (when assigned) -20%. This includes all in-classroom test, playing and written. In terms when written work is assigned, all portions of the grade will be 20%.

Semester grades are based on 25% for each 6-week grading period and 12.5 % for both the written and playing final exams.

Leadership Requirements

1. Maintain a 2.5 GPA.
2. Attend the required leadership meetings and camps.

The Don Antonio Lugo High School Band Boosters (DAL Band Boosters) is a Non-Profit Organization whose purpose is to provide financial and emotional support to the band and color guard program and its members. DAL Band Boosters are a group of parents dedicated to the ongoing success of the band program.

Parents and extended family are encouraged to become members; there are many events that require your assistance. The students, and your child, truly benefit from the team environment. We meet monthly on Tuesday nights at 7:00 in the band room and membership is \$10.00.

The DAL Band Boosters are responsible for most financial transactions of the DAL Band program. In other words: **we raise money!**

We pay for the instructor's monthly stipends, entrance fees for competitions, all bus transportation, purchase equipment and supplies, and any unexpected expense that the school district does not fund.

Financial info for Don Lugo Band 2009/2010

Students' financial commitment is referred to as "Fair Share"

A "Fair Share" program has been established to meet the needs of the band program. Each band member is responsible for payment – either by fundraising and/or making payments, during the course of summer, fall and early winter (see payment schedule). These funds are used for:

Bus transportation, competition entry fees, instrument purchase and repair, sheet music, equipment, support staff salaries, uniforms and all other expenditures necessary to run the program. The school district provides a classroom and instructor, limited instruments and marching uniform. All other costs are paid by fair share payments, fundraising, and donations.

The breadth and depth of our band program is greatly influenced by the amount of funds raised by its members.

If a student is not current with fair share according to the payment schedule, they will be deemed financially ineligible.

2009-2010 Anticipated Costs

- ♫ Fair Share - \$500
- ♫ Summer Leadership Camp (Leaders only) \$145
- ♫ Color Guard Training Camp - All members \$150
- ♫ Trip – Optional (rotate each year)
 1. Winter – approximately \$600
 2. Spring – approximately \$1800



The DAL Band Booster Treasurer is responsible for keeping all credit records. Money will be credited to the students' account in the following ways:

Direct Donation – 100% goes to fair share credit

Ad Sponsorship – 50% goes to fair share credit

Scrip – 100% of profit goes to the fair share credit (see order form for % credits)

Designated Fundraiser Events (Fireworks, Cow Chip Bingo, Bingo, etc.) – Profit will be credited to the accounts according to the amount determined by the Booster club.

You will be notified on a monthly basis, either by email or US mail, as to the status of your fair share and trip account. If you would like more frequent updates you will be able to access your account on the website or you may contact the booster treasurer.

Please adhere to the following rules:

1. Make sure you are clear on payment deadlines.
2. You may make credit card payments through Paypal at www.donlugobandboosters.com website. There is a 3% service fee from Paypal.
3. Make checks and money orders payable to DAL Band Boosters.
4. Payments are due at the monthly booster meeting. If you cannot attend a meeting you may drop the payment off with the band director at school.
5. Returned checks are subject to a bank service fee. This fee will be added to your student's account.
6. After 2 returned checks, you must pay by cash or Paypal.
7. Failure to pay fees on the scheduled due date will jeopardize you student's ability to perform.
 - If your student is dismissed from the unit or leaves the program, you are still responsible for all mandatory fees, non-returnable purchases and non-refundable deposits.
8. Monies earned from scrip and fundraisers are not refundable.

Fundraising

In order to support the many goals of our band, and to reduce the direct out of pocket expense, we must fundraise. Each and every year we try to increase our fundraising efforts. The band has numerous fund raising opportunities including ongoing SCRIP and sponsorship programs.



Parent and Student involvement is critical if we want the band to succeed!

On certain fundraisers, student accounts will receive direct benefit. Other fundraisers benefit the "general" band booster fund and thus reduce everyone's out of pocket cost.

Fundraisers to help pay Fair Share:

These fundraisers are applied to the students fair share account.

- ♫ Corporate Sponsorships: Student solicited donations from the community. 50% goes toward your student's account.
- ♫ Scrip – Works like a retailer's gift card. A designated percent of the face value is credited to your student's account.
- ♫ Fireworks Booth – Parents earn money towards their student's fair share.
- ♫ Other: Entertainment Books, brochure sales, carwashes etc. A portion of the sale profits go to student's fair share account.

Fundraisers to help the General Funds:

**Mandatory participation
Is required
for these
3 Fundraisers:**

1. Don Lugo Field show – October 3rd a one-day event hosted by the band boosters. All parents will be assigned.
2. DON LUGO CONCERT FESTIVAL – March – A two-day music festival hosted by the band boosters. All musician parents will be assigned a day and time
3. COW CHIP BINGO – May – Band hosts event. All parents are required to sell a minimum of 10 tickets or \$50.00 will be charged to your account.

Additional Fundraisers include:

- ♫ Snow Cone Booth at the Chino Summer Concerts – Each week a different band section is assigned to work the booth.
- ♫ Dinner Night Out – Each month a different restaurant in Chino will donate a % of their draw from the DAL band families.
- ♫ Affiliate programs with online stores. We have set up special links with online stores listed on our website: www.donlugobandboosters.com/fundraisers.html when you click on the text link, or banner, you will be taken to that online store. Any purchase you make (without leaving that store), DAL Boosters will receive a commission on that sale. No added cost to you or the Boosters.
- ♫ Borders Gift Wrap – December - Students gift-wrap customer's packages for a donation.
- ♫ Holiday Concert – December – Band and Performing Arts sell refreshments.

Financial obligations not met are turned into ASB for collection. Participation in school functions, graduation and student's diploma will be withheld until all financial obligations are fulfilled. If you

have questions please speak to a member of the executive board.

Once your fair share obligation is met, funds earned through various fundraisers can be credited to your 'Trip' account. There will be many opportunities for parents and students to participate in fundraising activities to earn money for their financial obligations. We encourage you to take advantage of these opportunities.

How important is parent involvement during High School?

A three-year study of 12,000 students in nine high schools revealed that parent involvement is most effective in improving academic achievement. It concluded that, "When parents come to school regularly, it reinforces the view in the child's mind that school and home are connected, and that school is an integral part of the whole family's life."

Parent participation is essential to the success of the program.

We can't operate without dedicated volunteers helping.

Commitments to work at certain events must be honored, or the program suffers a financial loss that has to be made up somewhere else. Making time to help at events throughout the entire year shows your child that you are truly supporting them and all their hard work.

Plus it is FUN!



Every organization has a set of committees to ensure smooth operation; we have split our committees into teams:

"North" Committee:

Food:

- Coordinate a meal or snack for the kids during competitions.

Video/Photography:

- Take pictures and video of band and guard members at events.

Website:

- Maintain donlugobandboosters.com web site.

Scholarship Committee:

- Distribution of applications: Chairperson will recruit five booster parents of non-senior students.



"East" Committee

Snow Cones

- Coordinate weekly snow cone booth during the City of Chino Summer Concerts in the Park series.

End of Band Camp Dinner

- Coordinate arrangements for the meal.

Uniform Chairperson - Band

- Issue uniforms at beginning of Marching season. Check in and inspect uniforms when season is over. List uniform numbers that need replacement or repair.

Stadium Set-up (Home Football Games)

- Coordinate set-up and take down of stadium seat covers and roping.

Concert Festival

- Coordinate the Snack Bar.

"South" Committee

Equipment Transportation

- Ensure that there are sufficient vehicles and parent volunteers to transport equipment to and from events.

Water / Ice Purchase & Transport

- Ensure water jugs are clean and filled for parades, football games and field shows and brought along in wagon.

Parade / Field Show

- Double check to make sure first aid and garment bags are brought on trips.
- Ensure shoes and uniforms are complete (glove, tabs) and clean on parade route.

Publicity Chairperson

- Submit monthly articles and pictures to the local newspaper, school announcements, and website to share information on band performances, results and events (i.e. fundraisers).

"West" Committee

Fundraising Committee

- Coordinate the fundraising activities through out the school year.

Dinner Night Chairperson

- Arrange dinner night monthly with local restaurants.

Fireworks Chairperson

- Coordinate with fireworks representative on set up.

Uniform - Color Guard Chairperson

- Ensure Uniform contracts are completed and signed before distribution of uniform.
- Check in and inspect uniforms when season is over.

Carwash Chairperson

- Coordinate operation of carwash fundraisers.

Sponsorships: There are two types of sponsorships available to help you raise money for your student’s account.

\$ Student Sponsorship form:

Students may use this form to solicit money from family members and friends. The entire amount of the cash donation will be credited to the student’s fair share account.

\$ Corporate and Business Sponsorship form:

Students and parents may use this form to solicit money from local business/corporations. 50% of the cash donation will be applied to the student’s fair share account and the balance will be put into the general fund.
