The Executive Board conducts business and provides leadership in accordance with the purposes and objectives of the band booster organization.

Below is a brief job description of the positions

President:

- Presides over all scheduled meetings of the membership and the Executive Board of the organization
- Selects an auditor to review the DAL Band Boosters books and present the finished audit at the September general membership meeting.

Vice President:

- In the event of the resignation of the President, the Vice President shall assume the duties of that position.
- Responsible for keeping a complete inventory of all band/colorguard equipment (and its location) purchased or acquired by the band boosters.

Secretary

- Record and maintain separate minutes of all Executive Board and general membership meetings. Minutes of previous meetings will be typed and available at the following meeting for review.
- Prepare and maintain any required booster club correspondence.

Treasurer

- Responsible for the receipt and disbursement of all the organization’s funds.
- Responsible for maintaining the organization’s bank account(s) and preparing a financial report for each monthly Executive Board meeting. The report will be presented at the general membership meeting.

Member(s) at Large

- Provide support for the Executive Board members.

Colorguard Representative

- Serve as a liaison with band director, colorguard instructors and parents.

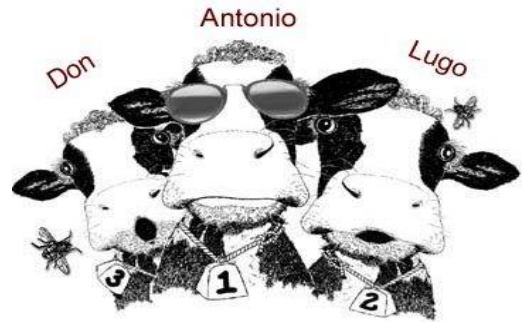
- Coordinate Colorguard and Winterguard events with crew; facilitate pre-approved costumes, uniforms and equipment acquisitions and distribution.
