Regional Festival and we hope to be there again next year. Congratulations on your achievements.

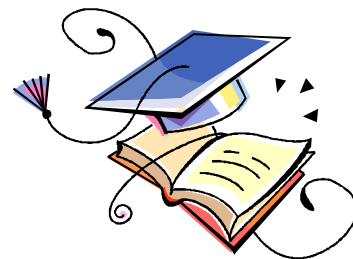
The Executive Board for 2008-09 was elected at the last booster meeting. They are:

We will be holding several fundraisers this summer.



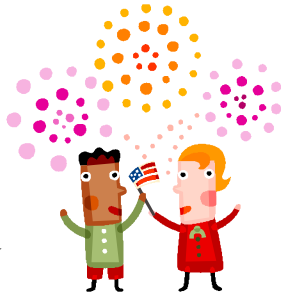
Car Washes - most Saturdays at MK Smith on the corner of 10<sup>th</sup> and Riverside.
